Fee Schedule & Policies

Docketing Fee: \$250

Rates:

- **Labor Cases:** \$1,800 per diem or \$258 per hour for labor arbitrations, Fees are prorated if the day (including travel) is less than four (4) hours (four (4) hours or less will incur ½ day fee) or extends beyond seven (7) hours (hours over seven (7) will be charged @ \$258 per hour for arbitration/ \$100 per hour for mediation). Additional fees may be charged for unusual collection efforts on the same terms.
- **Employment Cases:** \$475 per hour for hearing and travel; \$400 per hour for study; \$250 flat docketing fee.
- **Mediation Cases.** \$1,200 per diem for mediation cases, regardless of case type. Fees are prorated if the day (including travel) is less than four (4) hours (four (4) hours or less will incur a ½-day fee) or extends beyond seven (7) hours (hours over seven (7) will be charged at \$170 per hour).
- Additional fees may be charged for unusual collection efforts on the same terms regardless of case type.

Cancellation/Postponement:

No cancellation fee is charged if notice of cancellation or postponement is received at least 31 days before the scheduled hearing date.

A \$1,800 cancellation fee is charged if notice of cancellation or postponement of a labor or employment arbitration hearing is received 31 or fewer days before the scheduled hearing date. A \$1,200 fee is charged if notice of cancellation of a mediation session is received 15 or fewer days before the scheduled mediation date.

Travel (Other than Parking /Tolls):

If within 50 miles of the arbitrator's regional address, no travel costs will be billed. If more than 50 miles from the arbitrator's regional address, parties will be charged for reasonable actual costs of travel (ride service or mileage and any airfare) and lodging. If travel is necessary on the day before or after a hearing, a prorated per diem will be assessed for actual travel time, based on an eight-hour day.

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Parking/Tolls: Actual costs incurred.

Invoices:

Arbitration invoices are divided equally between the parties absent other agreements contained in the collective bargaining agreement or otherwise suitably memorialized on record. Invoices are payable within 30 days of issue.

Payments:

The arbitrator will accept checks, ACH, or credit cards for invoice payments. ACH or credit card payments are subject to additional convenience/processing fees based on the payment processors' fee schedule.
